Business pathways are designed to groom and prepare students to pursue a college degree, land an entry-level position in a business-related field, or run their own businesses. These programs include options for students to earn industry certifications and college credit while in high school!

Courses cover a variety of topics including: financial planning, banking, insurance, entrepreneurship, and accounting. Students in the Business & Finance program participate in competitive events through Business Professionals of America (BPA) and Network For Teaching Entrepreneurship (NFTE).





Business Program Offerings

Accounting

In the Accounting pathway, students explore the fundamentals of accounting through hands-on training and classroom projects. Students prepare financial statements, maintain business records, and manage money. This program provides students the opportunity to earn both the QuickBooks and WISE Personal Financial Literacy Certifications.

Entrepreneurship

Students in the Entrepreneurship pathway learn what it takes to establish, own, and operate a small business. The pathway's goal is for students to learn to write, present, and defend a business plan. Students are provided with the opportunity to earn a WISE Personal Financial Literacy Certification making them highly competitive in today's job market.
